They stand as just two of the many websites on the internet to be put under government censorship and influence by the new bills being proposed to pass in America. The Stop Online Piracy Act. After a summary release to an advisory SOPA, was introduced in the House of Representatives on October 26th, 2011 by Texas representative Lamar Smith. A bill in which could possibly bring the beginning of the end to modern American freedoms. What do you think? Let's have a quick run-down...

### SOPA's Goal:

Once the bill is passed, the government will use it to target every site known, hosting, website, such as websites like the most well known, [Proxmox.org](http://www.proxmox.org), will either be shut down all together or heavily censored to the point of unusability. At its best, SOPA is designed to stop online piracy of media such as movies, television series, video games, and music. All of which are industries that are heavily dependent on the customer wanting what they were built for a licensed copy of their product. Sure you could argue that movies don't make money from DVD sales or that bands don't get rich off of album sales, but that's a myth. It's not what the true concern for SOPA, while

soundly innocent enough, could very well be the loose thread that unravels the entire that is our freedom and way of life.

The real difference is seen in the fact that this bill wouldn't just allow the government to just censor content, but making entire websites and domains blocked from viewing. Very few websites have the access or funding for a team of lawyers the content sites like Google or Facebook. It would make it nearly impossible for small nonprofit information based websites such as Wikipedia or WikiLeaks.

As a form of protest, Wikipedia shut down it's entire site for 24 hours to announce what the results of SOPA would mean for web accessibility. It was a good move on the website side, people often do not know what an immense sized Wikipedia is for today's fast paced cyber society.

If the American government were to have the power to start censoring anything they see fit on the internet, how are we to know if we are really being fair to the truth from our usually trusted news and information sources on the web? We don't. With that said, comes a dark age for America. Corporations will then have more rights than that of its actual citizens, which goes against democracy in a big way.
